Points to note		
① When studying in the field in Oze, you will need to prepare the necessary clothing and equipment for hiking. Please also be prepared for heat stroke as August is a very hot month. ② Cameras and other equipment may be used to record the activities in progress, and the data taken may be used. ③ As a measure to prevent COVID-19 infection, participants with a fever of 37.5° C or higher on the day of the meeting will not be allowed to participate. ④ Depending on conditions such as typhoons and torrential rains, some of the activities may be changed, postponed, or canceled.		

Travel Conditions This document on the Travel Conditions is a part of the document issued for Explanation on Terms of Transaction in accordance with the Article 12-4, and also a part of the Contract Document in accordance with the Article 12-5, of Travel Agency Law. 1. Method of and Conditions for Application; Conclusion of Contract

(1) The Traveler must apply the method specified by the Company. Application fee as specified below must be paid by the designated method and the date specified by the Company. The application fee shall be treated as part or all of a "travel fee", a "cancellation fee" or a "penalty."

(2) The Contract is not in effect at the time of the application. The Contract enters into effect when the Company has agreed to the conclusion of the Contract and received the application fee.

(3) Depending on your circumstances, such as customers with disabilities, elderly customers, or pregnant customers, special considerations or measures may be required that are not included in the original arrangements. If you may need special consideration or measures, please be sure to let us know in advance so that we can consult with you.

2. Payment of Travel Fee

Amount of Application: Full travel fee

3. Expenses Covered by Travel Fee, Expenses Excluded from Travel Fee

The travel fee covers transportation, lodging, meals, etc., and their consumption tax equivalents as indicated in the itinerary.

The charges are not refundable even when the Traveler does not use a part of the services mentioned.

Transportation, meals, and other expenses of a personal nature not included in the itinerary are not included.

The Certified Travel Services Manager is responsible for all transactions made at the office which deals with the travel concerned.
The Traveler is free to ask the Certified Travel Services Manager any questions regarding the Contract of this travel in cases where is unclear.

4. Cancellation of Contract

(1) A Traveler may cancel the Contract at any time on payment to the Company of the cancellation fee specified in the table below. The date of cancellation is determined as the date the Traveler contacts the Company to make cancellation during the Company's business hours.

Date of Cancellation of the Contract	Cancellation fee
If cancellation is made on or after the 20th day (10th day in case of a one day trip) up to the 8th day prior to the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel	20% of the travel fee
If cancellation is made on or after the 7th day up to the 2nd day prior to the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel	30% of the travel fee
If cancellation is made on the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel	40% of the travel fee
If cancellation is made on the date of commencement of the travel	50% of the travel fee
In case of cancellation after the commencement of the travel or of nonparticipation without communication	100% of the travel fee

(2) The Traveler will also be subject to the payment of the cancellation fee specified in the table above in the case where he/she requests that the Company change the date of commencement of the travel and/or the travel course(s), and when the number of the participants of his/her group is reduced.

5. Processing of Personal Data

The Company will use the personal information of the traveler obtained at the time of application for the tour to the extent necessary for the Company to contact the traveler, to arrange the services provided by the transportation, accommodation agencies and agents, etc. for the tour for which the traveler has applied, and to complete the procedures for receiving such services.

Please note that personal information may also be used to provide information on our campaigns, to conduct questionnaires to solicit opinions and feedback, and to send DMs and other communications.
